

Septic Do's & Don'ts

We do NOT have a city sewer system, we have independent septic systems.

Use water efficiently, conserve when possible.

Do NOT flush or pour down the sink the following items: Cooking oil, paint, dental floss, tampons, condoms, diapers, cotton swabs, cigarette butts, coffee grounds, cat litter, paper towels or food.





The office does not accept packages or mail. You may apply for one of the mailboxes located by the old Admin building. You need to go to the Post Office in Sussex located in the Acme plaza. They will be able to give you further information. The office will accept medications only.

NEW Propane Information



Expired tanks CANNOT be filled! Any tank that is older than 12 years of age (for 2020 that means tanks made before the same month of 2008) is expired and cannot be refiled.

How To Check Your Tank's Expiration

Every tank of propane has a date stamped into the collar along the top of the tank. There are some important numbers and letters here that mark:

- Serial Number
- Water Content (WC)
- Tare Weight (TW)

Manufacturing Date

The date is shown in MM-YY format, so to know if your tank is expired just subtract 12 from the second number. If your stamp is not more recent than the current month 12 years ago, your tank is **expired**.

Other Factors That Might Disqualify A Tank Refill

An expired tank isn't the only reason your tank might not be eligible to be refilled. Propane tanks need to have a device on them called an OPD, or Overfill Protection Device. When a tank is being filled with propane, these devices automatically shut off the valve when the tanks reach a certain capacity. If your tank doesn't have an OPD, we aren't able to fill that tank.

Another factor which might cause a tank to be disqualified from being refilled is its general condition. If your tank has visible rust or damage anywhere on it, it could be unsafe to fill it and therefore would be disqualified from receiving a refill.

Recertified Tanks

Tanks that are past their normal expiration date can be re-certified by someone who is trained to do so. If the inspector deems the tank's condition to be usable, they will put a sticker on the tank with an "E" after the manufacturing date. This "E" adds another 5 years to the life of the tank.



Tall Timbers Propane Tanks for Purchase

If you have a tank that has expired, for your convenience Tall Timbers sells new 100# and 20# tanks.

100# \$210 (+tax) Propane Fill \$110.00 20# \$70 (+tax) Propane Fill \$22.00

We will even take your old one and make sure that it is properly disposed of!

Remember, expired tanks will NOT be filled

GARBAGE & DEBRIS



The dumpster area is located at the Tall Timbers entrance at the side of the Guard House. Please place your garbage in the appropriate containers.

<u>The Compactor</u> – Household garbage <u>ONLY</u>. Place all bags containing food into the compactor to avoid attracting animals. If the compactor is full, please notify the guard on duty.

<u>The Open Tops</u> – Bulk items only. **NO FOOD!** (This will attract the bears!)

Recycle Bin – Paper, plastic, glass and aluminum only. Please be sure to rinse any food out.

<u>Red Dumpster</u> – Scrap metal only. Do not throw old propane tanks in the dumpster, please contact the office for proper disposal methods.

Please dispose of your garbage properly and never feed the wild animals. Animals fed by humans tend to become nuisance animals and/or become dependent on humans for survival. This is there home as well as yours; we need to respect each other. You can do your part to help prevent most problems by just respecting the wildlife laws. By doing our part we can ensure the safety of our site owners and wildlife alike!

There are bears in the campgrounds all the time. This is their home. They look for food and have been spotted climbing into our dumpsters and bringing out food garbage bags. We do our best to deter them but these bears have become accustomed to humans. If you put your food garbage in the dumpster instead of the compactor, they will drag it out and make a huge mess. Besides the aesthetics, it can become a health hazard! It also takes our Maintenance Crew away from other important jobs. ANY KIND OF FOOD GARBAGE MUST GO INTO THE COMPACTOR!! The bears in our community are wild bears; you should never feed them! If the bears find food in the dumpster, they will continue to go there & make a mess of your campground. Please do your part and put your trash in the right place. Be considerate! Your Maintenance Department will have to pick up after the bears...and you! Help us keep your Tall Timbers clean!
